



UPPER SCHOOL UNIFORM

Boy Boarders

Every item brought into school must be named. Any and all medication must be handed in to Matron on arrival. All clothes, duvet covers, towels etc, must have **sewn-on**, woven nametapes as written, iron-on, click on or stick-on names wash off, break off or fade. The school uniform shop has details of a nametape sewing service if required.

A simple watch may be worn but no other wrist bands/bracelets. Boys' hair should be above the collar, ears and eyebrows.

General	
6 pairs	Underpants
6 pairs	Short Grey socks
3	White vests (optional but recommended)
2 pairs	Pyjamas
1	Dressing gown
1 pair	Slippers
1	Hairbrush and comb
1	Shampoo – named with permanent marker
1	Shower gel – named with permanent marker
1	Toothbrush – named with permanent marker. All toothbrushes need to be replaced every term. Please note that there is no practical way to charge an electric toothbrush in the boarding house. If you wish your son to have one, please supply a battery powered brush, we recommend the disposable kind.
1	Toothpaste – named with permanent marker
1	Sun cream (F30+) summer term only, named
1	Wash bag
2	Duvet covers (single size, poly-cotton) named on the corner, matching pillow cases are optional.
1	'Tuck box' with combination padlock
1	Plastic box for tuck (no bigger than a shoe box)
12	Name tapes
1	Reading book (to be kept in the dorm)

Uniform – all terms, all year groups	
1	School blazer
1	St George's jacket
1 pair	Black leather school shoes (suitable for polishing)
2	Blue St George's School jumpers
2	School ties (Prefects x 1)
1	St George's Beanie hat (optional but recommended)
1	St George's School scarf (optional)
1 pair	Plain navy blue gloves (optional but recommended)
1	St George's School backpack

Winter – all year groups	
3	Blue long sleeve shirts
2 pairs	Blue corduroy trousers

Summer – year groups 4 - 5	
3	Blue short-sleeve shirts
2 pairs	Grey shorts

Summer – year groups 6 - 8	
3	Blue short-sleeve shirts
2 pairs	Grey trousers (Choristers will have these in school already)

CHORISTERS – all terms	
2	Long-sleeve white shirt (probationers x 1 with growing room)
2 pairs	Long grey trousers (probationers x 1 with growing room)
1	Red St George's Chapel Choir sweatshirt for stay-on etc.

Sports Kit

As well as being labelled on the inside with standard nametapes, all sports clothing, other than footwear, must be labelled on the outside with large, red, sewn-on initials. Tops need to be named on the left chest and bottoms on the left thigh.

Winter	
1	St George's School reversible games shirt
1	Rugby/football navy shorts
2 pairs	Long red & navy stripe sports socks
1 pair	Studded boots (safety studs)
1 pair	Shin pads
1	Custom-made mouthguard for rugby (year 4 and over)

Summer	
1 or 2 pairs	Long cricket trousers Note: Cricket trousers are generally sold unhemmed so that the length can be adjusted. Although they are supplied with

	an iron-on hemming strip (which washes off), please ensure hems are sewn for durability before the beginning of term.
1	St George's cricket top
1	St George's School cricket jumper
1	White St George's baseball-style cap* or St George's white cricket hat
1 pair	Cricket boots (optional)
1	Cricket box (with specialist underwear to hold it)
1	Navy blue cricket helmet for those playing hard-ball cricket. Hard-ball cricket is phased in from Year 5 onwards
1	Small non-spray container of sun cream*

Home Clothes

Please note that all clothes should be machine washable and tumble-dryer safe.

Full Boarders and Full Choristers (Weekly Boarders and Probationary Choristers only need one of each item)	
1-2	Home clothes top – short sleeve (2 x summer, 1 x winter)
1-2	Home clothes top – long sleeve (1 x summer, 2 x winter)
1	Home clothes warm top
2	Home clothes trousers
1-2	Home clothes shorts or cropped trousers
1 pair	Home trainers (not used for sport)
1	Non-uniform swimming trunks (optional but recommended)
1	Non-uniform coat (optional)

Other items that may be brought into school; all are optional, and are brought in at your own risk and must be clearly named:-

Teddy or similar
Kindle (No tablets, laptops, netbooks etc.)
Hand held games console and games
I-Pod, MP3 or similar
Wallet (must be handed in to staff)
Mobile phone (must be handed in to staff)

Musical instruments and music

Instruments and music must be in cases, which must be clearly named. Boarding staff will show the boys where to store them.

If there is something else you would like to bring to school and are not sure if it is suitable or permitted, please contact the Boarding house staff or matrons for advice.
