Year 2 Curriculum Overview – Lent Term 2019

English	Descriptive writing, story writing, information reports. Read Write Inc spelling programme. Reading and comprehension. Punctuation and grammar.
Maths	Multiplication and informal division. Addition and subtraction Number patterns. Length, Mass. Problem solving.
Science	Forces / Space/Variation and classification.
Geography	Exploring different countries from around the world: climate, location, notable landmarks, animal life (Italy, Canada, China and Australia).
History	Famous People: Boudicca, George Stephenson, Alexander Graham Bell, Amy Johnson, Neil Armstrong. History of Space.
Religious Studies	Life of Jesus. Parables and Miracles. Looking at the New Testament stories and the stories told by Jesus. Festivals of spring season. Mothering Sunday and Easter.
French	Traditional stories e.g. 3 little pigs Clothes Food Cross curricular links: English: Stories- The Three Little Pigs Geography- Weather Science healthy eating- Food RE- Easter Weather Easter activities
PSHCE	Strengths and Weaknesses. Responsibility. Resolving Conflicts. Helping others. Cooperation. Appreciating who we are. Different characteristics. Feelings and Emotions.
Computing	Searching the internet: learning how to find images and information from the internet. Espresso Coding Unit 2B
Art	Learning about printing using a variety of media. Painting and drawing from observation. Creating pictures using a variety of media linked to cross-curricular work. Famous artists.
Music	Development of pitch and singing skills: songs from around the world. Discriminating between high and low sounds. Listening: Peter and the Wolf.
PE	Skipping – learning to skip and participating in a sponsored skip. Music and movement – creating dances. Swimming – continuation of the technical development in the three main strokes.
Boys Games	Tag Rugby: basic ball skills, passing & catching, pick up & grounding, positions and responsibilities during game play.
Girls Games	Netball – chest pass, shoulder pass, body management, passing, receiving the ball. Teamwork, fair play and sportsmanship. Basic hockey skills
DT	Making a key-ring holder; an introduction to the workshop by learning to use hand tools, the pillar drill and the importance of a good 'finish'.
