**Year 6 Curriculum Overview – Trinity Term 2019**

<b>English</b>	Writing Skills: focus on continued comprehension practice and use of 11+ CE papers. Poetry and speech writing for debate. Exam revision – 11+ Grammar and Punctuation: continued work on parts of speech, suffixes, proofreading Spelling: continued spelling practice and tests Class Reader: 'Tom's Midnight Garden' 6X1/2 and 'My Friend Walter' 6X3.
<b>Maths</b>	Calculations including order of operations, fractions, decimals and percentages, angles of regular polygons including interior and exterior angles, bearings, revision for exams, probability including venn diagrams.
<b>Science</b>	The Skeletal system. Separating mixtures: using techniques such as filtration, distillation & chromatography. Electricity & electrical circuits
<b>Geography</b>	Africa. Food and Farming in Kenya – inc subsistence farming. Sustainable Development. Map work.
<b>History</b>	Medieval England - How medieval people lived, Henry II and Thomas Becket, King John and the Magna Carta and The Black Death.
<b>Music</b>	Recognising instruments; key signatures; continued recognition of notes; <i>Aurelia</i> and <i>Musition</i> software. Preparation for <i>Mary Poppins</i> .
<b>Religious Education</b>	Major Christian festivals and seasons including, Ascension and Pentecost. The growth of the Early Church. Christian initiation services: Baptism and Confirmation
<b>Computing</b>	Typing and Espresso Coding Unit 6B
<b>PSHCE</b>	Pupil Council Drugs Education – Alcohol abuse SEAL links: Keeping myself Safe CITIZENSHIP: GB - A Multi-Cultural Society, stereotyping
<b>French</b>	6XT, 6XG: Expo 2 Vert: leisure with friends, TV programmes, last weekend, invite someone to go out & making excuses, describe clothes 6XS: Expo 2 Rouge: as 6X2 plus opinion about TV programmes, TV habits, describe own and other people's last weekend, what you are going to wear
<b>Spanish</b>	Mira 1 – Unit 2 (3): brothers and sisters, likes and dislikes of school subjects, snacks Grammar: conjugation ( sing.) of "tener" and "gustar", adjectival endings, possessive adjectives mi(s), tu(s) and su(s)
<b>Latin</b>	2 <sup>nd</sup> Conjugation in two tenses. Infinitives. 2 <sup>nd</sup> declension neuter and masculine. Translation from and into Latin, revising all vocabulary and endings taught thus far. Roman Legends including Aeneas, Romulus and Remus, and the Etruscans.
<b>DT</b>	Design and make a phone stand using CAD / CAM, and make a speaker, including soldering the circuit and vacuum-forming the case.
<b>Art</b>	Printing and painting. Artist study – Optical art.
<b>PE</b>	Athletics: pupils taught the correct technique for each event and assessed in line with the STG award scheme. Track events: sprints, hurdles, distance, relays. Field events: high jump, long jump, shot putt.
<b>Boys' Games</b>	CRICKET: Team selection (Colts A,B,C & Development). Fielding skills. Bowling technique. Batting. Fielding positions. Running between wickets

	/ communication. Hard ball for A, B and C's later in term. Incredi-ball for Developments - timed / limited over game.
<b>Girls' Games</b>	CRICKET and ROUNDEES: introduction to the basic cricket skills of batting/bowling/fielding and match play Throwing - fielding in from the deep positions. Catching - one-handed. Bowling and fielding speed and accuracy. Hitting - correct foot placement. Attempting to hit for direction and distance.
<b>Food Technology</b>	Introduction to safe food handling and learning to follow a recipe step-by-step.
